01 Research & Content Development:

The team has conducted interviews and analyzed best practices across Europe to shape the toolkit's content.

02 Collaboration with Partners:

Experts in construction training, digital learning, and refugee integration have contributed to refining the kit's structure.

03 Translation & Accessibility:

Work is underway to ensure the Starter Kit is available in multiple languages, to reach as many beneficiaries as possible.

04 Pilot Testing:

Initial versions of the Starter Kit have been shared with VET providers and employers to gather feedback.
